After more than 10 days of island touring my husband and I arrived in Edgartown and stopped in at Chesca's at the advise of a friend. We are so glad we did. With no reservations in the middle of July, we were seated in about 30 minutes. Not bad!! We started with what my husband and I deemed to be the BEST Clam Chowder we have ever had. The smokey bacon flavor, rich creamy sauce was not too thick, there were many clams and it was not laden with potatoes as most other's are. It was heaven. We also enjoyed the mussels. For entrees my husband had the swordfish, cooked to perfection. I'm not sure about the rest, because my mind was on the Risotto with duck and cranberry's. Short of licking the plate clean, I scooped up every delicious morsel. I'd love the recipe and will persue!! I'll be back to enjoy more great food at Chesca's!!

Chesca's is my favorite restaurant. I have had dinner ther maybe 10 or 12 times in the past several years. Somehow it is always rather exciting to be seated in what I consider to be an extraordinarily good restaurant. Why do I think it is extraordinary? We have rented a house every summer since then and we without a doubt have dinner here at least once, if not more. Food is phenomenal. I always get the lobster ravioli and seared sea scallops. Can't lose. The atmosphere is a toned-down romantic. Dim lights and cozy dining room cater to a perfect date night restaurant or simply a night out without the kids. The lack of reservations for parties under 6 is inconvenient sometimes but who cares...you're on vacation. Sit out on the porch with a cocktail or walk to David Ryan's across the street and have a drink there. The entrees are a little pricey if you are bringing your 3 year old but for adults, the food is well worth what you pay for.
